The Department of Agricultural and Consumer Sciences (ACS) at Tarleton State University, Stephenville, Texas, is seeking a tenure-track faculty member at the rank of Assistant Professor in the area of Agri-Industries and Agencies. The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in agricultural industries, agencies and related areas. The department offers Bachelor of Science Degrees in the areas of Agri-Industries & Agencies, Agricultural Education, Agricultural Communication, Agribusiness, Horticulture and a Master of Science Degree in Agricultural and Consumer Resources. Online teaching will also be required of this faculty member. The person selected for this position will be expected to conduct research in areas related to agricultural and extension education. The Department of Agricultural and Consumer Sciences has 12 faculty members and is seeking a person that can be a member of a departmental team to produce quality graduates and research. The successful candidate will be expected to advise both graduate and undergraduate students and work with student recruitment and other activities as assigned.

Candidates must have an earned doctorate in Agricultural Extension, Agricultural Education or a closely related field, and completed three years of experience in the Cooperative Extension Service or a related Agricultural Agency. The successful candidate should also possess the following:

- The ability and desire to recruit, teach, and advise university students;
- Effective written, verbal, and interpersonal communication skills;
- The ability and desire to secure funding and produce a sustained program of scholarship; and
- Demonstrated leadership experience with 4-H and/or FFA programs.

Review of applications will begin March 1, 2017 and continue until the position is filled.
