All salaries for appointments greater than 9-month were converted to a 12-month equivalent salary by taking their current salary times (11 / Monthly Appointment).
- 2. The sample size varied among tables due to missing data.
- 3. Due to missing data, values among tables should not be compared.
- 4. Information was not reported for cells with a frequency less than 3.
- 5. Table 5, page 6 represents what was reported as the College Average Starting Salaries.
- 6. The data was presented as reported; while it was spot-checked, it was not verified.
