A total of 98 proposals were received for consideration for presentation at the 2006 Agricultural Education Research Conference. Reviewers were solicited from throughout the country. Each paper was evaluated by three or 4 members of the review team. Papers were selected using z-scores. Forty-eight papers were selected for presentation (49% acceptance rate).
