2. You will be notified by August 17, 2021, if you have been identified to host a session. If similar topics are proposed, you may be asked to combine sessions to avoid redundancy.
3. If selected to host a session, you will be responsible for promoting, chairing (or co-chairing) and coordinating the activities for that session.
